The United States of America Code of Federal Regulations states: § 4710.5 Closure to livestock grazing. If necessary to provide habitat for wild horses or burros, to implement herd management actions, or to protect wild horses or burros, to implement herd management actions, or to protect wild horses or burros from disease, harassment or injury, the authorized officer may close appropriate areas of the public lands to grazing use by all or a particular kind of livestock.

Just one of the areas FS has failed to comply, no where in the Management Draft does it face the issues of Multi use. The fact the Heber Wild Horses have lived throughout the Sitgreaves National Forest since the 1600's. And According to the WFRHB Act their Territory shall be the lands in which they were orginally found.

I feel that considering the impact their proposed plan will have as far as ridding Our National Forest of Heber Wild Horses a full Environmental Impact Study needs to be done and should have been done before this final draft was made public .
