Giving more of it away would be reckless! On the contrary, they should be made responsible for restoration to reverse the harm to the land that continues for generations. Who of us wouldn't like a free gift of public lands to perpetuity with no questions asked and no liabilities?

Please oppose these un-scientific and destructive proposed new rules. They will only take us further unto unhealthy ecosystems.
