Comments: Leave the Heber wild horses that roam Heber territory, Black Mesa Ranger district and forest between ALONE .

They have not doubled the herd size every 4 yrs as predicted by the BLM. In addition wild horses are protected "where presently found" by PL 92-195, the Wild Free Roaming Horses and Burros act of 1971. The Forrest Service cannot remove horses unless they are determined excess. This habitat has not been monitored to determine that excess public horses rather than private cattle are damaging public habitat. Therefore the forest service CANNOT LEGALLY set its Appropriate Management Level at under 50 -104 animals. For death or sterilization
