Comments: "Appropriate" Management Level (AML) to an unnatural low number -- just 50-104 wild horses on 19,700 acres. Even at high AML, that's one horse for every 394 acres! This number is far too low to maintain a genetically viable population of wild horses in the Territory. This result will be the roundup of hundreds of wild horses in northern Arizona, from Forest Lakes all the way to Showlow.

The above calculations are far too low. These are OUR public lands and we do NOT want these horses rounded up and put in deplorable conditions at tax payer expense.
