As a business we are very concerned at what we see as an increasing problem that has magnified in the last 5 years. What used to be loud and annoying (many unmuffled) sounds from the dune park on weekends, has become daily extremely loud to the point we could not hear each other talk.

This will adversely affect our business. They start at dawn and continue well past midnight.

We have to keep our windows closed in the summer months.

Increasingly ambulances and rescue trucks fly down Sandlake rd. At very high speeds endangering us all. Not to mention the constant sirens.

I've spoken with deputy Mayne, which he says he is the sole enforcer. And he admits he does not go at night.

There is a lot of drinking, aren't there regulations?

A proposed lowering of the allowable decibel level not raising is more in line and getting more deputies to enforce what I feel has gotten out of hand.
