Regarding the Foothills Landscape Project, thank you for revising your strategy by considering the broader effects, taking public engagement into account, and committing to designate areas to manage for old-growth.

I fully endorse Georgia Forest Watch in their position on the project and hope that you will take the following actions to help our forests thrive:

Exclude Georgia's Mountain Treasures from commercial timber harvests.

Restrict commercial timber harvests to "fire adapted" forest types.

Exclude areas more than half a mile from a road.

Not cut all trees in attempts to regenerate southern yellow pine.

Not to thin (cut half of the trees) in mesic (moist) forests.

Manage forests & Deport them in their true cycles and co-dependencies

Choose Alternative 3 which excludes areas that the Forest Service's own plan identifies as "unsuitable" for "timber production."
