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Comments: The local groups that take care of the trails should be able to determine what is best for the trails at any given time. ORCA and locals have envisioned / built the Baileys from the bottom-up, they should be able to make the rules. Example: use basic science. Frozen trails are fine to ride and not cause damage, conditions that are typically present in winter months. At other times during the winter, extended dry periods are safe for bikes as well. The mandatory closing is lazy. People will still ride local city / state parks that do not have mandatory closings. Science and education is better.
