- Lack of base area, parking, general crowd flow in base area.
- Lack of green circle (easy) runs for children to learn on. Ullr Mountain is the only beginner focused lift and it gets crowded, due to lack of other beginner areas.
- Moose Mountain runs leave beginners stranded at bottom. Specifically, the runs furthest to the south, have long, almost flat terrain at the bottom that require "skating or poleing" long distances to get back to a lift. That is especially hard for younger skiers.
