Comments: I think the Lutsen Ski Resort expansion should not be approved as proposed. I would prefer to see no expansion at all. The North Shore of Lake Superior is a unique area because it is still largely undeveloped, with much natural beauty. It offers many recreational opportunities which are healthy and have a low impact on the natural environment.
