My friends and I drive the 7 hours to Lutsen specifically for the backside of Moose Mountain and the expert glades on the front of Moose Mountain. These runs at Lutsen were an incredible learning experience and taught us the skills to conquer many double black diamonds at the infamous Taos. Our biggest critique last time we came is that the lack of chairlift on the backside and recent demolition of the Bull chairlift made accessing this amazing advanced terrain a long and tiring process.
