I have personally had to clean up human waste and I know the Forest Service has had to also. Therefore, as far as dispersed camping in the Willamette National Forest goes, I strongly recommend that any campers camping in ANY dispersed campsite must be Self-Contained. Meaning, they must have toilet facilities available for their personal use. If they use a bucket, it must have a lid and the camper must take it with them when they leave the Forest. Any campers found camping in the dispersed campsites without toilet facilities should be cited and fined.
