In principal we are opposed to how alternative B for the Summer ROS areas designates areas between established travelled single track trails as primitive non-motorized as this precludes any future ability to add potential connectors.

Additionally below are trail specific concerns we have.

Alt B Summer has a semi-primitive motorized corridor on Fossil Ridge trail (TR#9478), Alt C Summer only has the corridor on the western half

Alt B Summer has semi-primitive motorized corridor on the entire length trails 7771, 9549 & amp; 9427 Alt C Summer has the connecting portion as semi-primitive non-motorized

Alt B Summer designates the areas between the trails east of highway 50 up to the Monarch Crest trail as semiprimitive non-motorized. This is a popular area that is already well travelled. Closing those areas will limit the ability to potentially add new connecting trails to help ensure reduced conflict. A specific example of this would be the ability to connected Agate Creek to Monarch Pass to allow loops clockwise down Monarch Crest. This will encourage motorized singletrack traffic to "go with the flow" of mountain bikers and hikers east to west.
