Comments: While I appreciate the sincere effort that has been put into developing the Santa Fe Mountains Landscape Resiliency Project, I feel that it is not a complete plan and has not had enough input from experts who disagree with the plan nor from the public at large.

I am most concerned about the amount of smoke that would be generated from a combination of prescribed burns and inevitable wildfires both within and outside treated areas. I also want to preserve the beautiful trees on our mountains; I believe that thinning proposed is excessive and will harm the remaining trees as well as create wind and drought and erosion conditions that will foster even more dangerous fires and kill precious wildlife. I fear that frequent burning will not allow the understory to return which is an important part of forest ecology.

Please reduce the proposed thinning, mastication, and burning. And please complete a full Environmental Impact Statement after consulting with a wider range of expert and public opinion.
