I just want to emphasize again the importance of protecting all the wetland areas, seeps and springs that feed riparian areas, nurture our streams and replenish groundwater. Lest we love our wilderness areas to death, lets cling to our values and current limitations on human traffic. No more roads, no more bicycle trails to disturb wildlife. I approve of all approaches to noxious weeds that exclude pesticides. I approve of prescribed burns and a broad ecological approach. The only thing you didn't cover was weather control and the relentless dispersion of silver iodide. How much of that, if any, is acceptable? Do we really understand the cumulative effects as it sinks into our watershed and ecosystem? What right do they have to change the weather without our consent? Did the Carson have a say in the decision? I will send the rest of my comments on the subject to NMISC.
