Chainsaws do not belong in Wilderness Areas. Machinery such as chainsaws goes against the intent of the Wilderness Act, which requires that crosscut and other types of handsaws be used when clearing trails.

The Forest Service should exclude all Wilderness areas from the proposed project, including any encroachment from activity on wilderness boundaries.
