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Comments: The proposal to replace the aging Fox Creek Bridge, including stream restoration, is important to our trail club. We maintain 59.4 miles of the Appalachian Trail under the Appalachian Trail Conservancy, including the AT as it crosses Fox Creek. The club did significant repair of the rock and log embankment wall ten years ago, but that repair was meant to be temporary until a better stream bank stabilization project could be performed. A tree, growing on a rock high up on the embankment threatens the current bridge, and so threatens hikers on the AT. Our trail club hopes that the proposal for a new bridge and bank stabilization will also plan to deter horse riders, who sometimes veer off the adjacent horse trail onto the AT where they are not allowed.
