I strongly disagree with expansion of motorized travel use. The amount of illegal motorized travel use has increased a tremendous amount over the 49 years I've been living in the Lander area and spending time in the Shoshone NF. Motorized travel is anathema to the concept of natural environment. There is never a time when it is not grossly abused, regardless of management intentions. I believe restriction is the only stop-gap with any kind of effectiveness.

There are already a number of very pretty, well maintained motorized travel ways in the Shoshone NF. I believe they quite adequately suffice to provide access to the mountains for those who are fine with seeing them while rolling along.

There are few areas in America not trampled by use. Those areas provide all the motorized travel that should be provided. I, Personally, would reduce motorized travel, and I don't believe there would actually be negative consequences in doing that.
