1)

OSV use dates should be Nov 1st through June 15th in my opinion. (Conditions allowing of course)

Snow travel leaves no trace once the snow melts. When adequate snow conditions allow, people should be allowed to use the areas for that purpose and not restricted.

2)

I strongly support the creation of new motorized trails that provide better access to public lands. I strongly urge the forest service to create multi-use single track trails. Proper management is key, not closure!

I urge the forest service to avoid implementing a permanent closure at the Pinnacles/Deception Peak Nordic ski area. No permanent closures are needed, proper management is!
