As a resident of Crested Butte I've witnessed exponentially increasing motorized use on our public landscape. With advances in motorized over snow technology, I'm especially concerned about negative ecological impacts associated with the greater range of snow machines.

To adequately manage negative future impacts, I believe Winter Travel Management Planning (WTMP) should start within ONE YEAR of completing the Revised Forest Plan. Final Winter Recreation Opportunity Settings (ROS) should be forward looking and determined during WTMP, not from the Revised Forest Plan.

I fully support all Recommended Wilderness areas proposed in Alternative D (including Gunnison Public Lands Initiative (GPLI) and other proposals). I urge the GMUG to envision management from a long-term perspective for the benefit of current and future generations.
