"Livestock watering and handling facilities (corrals, chutes, dipping vats, etc"

This is a NATIONAL FOREST which to me says its wildlife habitat = NOT cattle or sheep! I'm sure this area has recovered somewhat from the sheep grazing formerly present on this allotment. There is no need to put yet more domestic cattle and their "infrastructure" back into this area.

Multiple use certainly does not necessitate domestic cattle!
