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Comments: I agree with the letter submitted by the Uintah Cattlemen Association. It is vital that grazing is monitored on an allotment by allotment basis. It would be wrong and poor science to do a blanket plan for the entire forest. Every allotment is different and needs to be treated as such. Some grass never will reach the 4 inch stubble whether grazed or not, so why put parameters on something that will not be ever be achieved. Timber needs not to be limited. In the plan I believe that only 10-15 percent of the forest can be harvested for timber. It would be wrong to place such a small limit. The forest needs to have wood removed in order to maintain a healthy forest. The old clear has now filled in with dog hair pine trees that now need to be thinned to maintain a healthy forest and decrease fuel load.
