Doctor's Park: Specifically I think it would be great if we could re-route the wet portion of the trail between the top (end of the road, beginning of the trail) to the connection of the confluence of the CO Spur Trail. That wet section has seen some repairs, but re-routing to a drier area would solve the need for continued maintenance.

Upper Upper to Brush Creek Connection: The proposed single track to get riders off the road would be best situated as far from the road as possible. Of course, any trial is better than none, but for optimal user experience, the trail should be located as far from the road as possible.

Upper Cement Creek (saved the best for last): I have personally worked many many hours on the trail developments in Cement Creek, and personally I think the best part is yet to be built. Connecting Middle Cement all the way to Crystal Peak trail will be an amazing opportunity for beginner and intermediate riders as well as those looking to have a more peaceful experience in Upper Cement Creek drainage. That road (Cement Creek) sees a ton of motorized use, and I would never take my young child out there (on the road) to ride as an example. I know that the final section of the trail getting riders off the road will see as much if not more use than the lower sections. I also feel that the number of volunteers who continue to turn out for trail work in Cement Creek is a testament to the support this trail has in the valley. Not completing the single track would be a shame and a missed opportunity.

Last... toilets:

In the few years that temporary potties have been used, I have noticed such a positive difference... less toilet paper, excrement, etc at makeshift and designated trailheads. If there's a trailhead, there should be a toilet!
