Unfortunately, what's left on this current proposal isn't much but I am in agreement with all of the proposed trail additions and changes outlined by CBMBA. In my opinion this is a bare minimum plan to make the rides in the valley feel more connected, incrementally get better riding experiences, and keep people off the road. I would like to know why the North Valleys most asked for trail, Snodgrass reroute, was struck from this proposal at the behalf of a select few individuals with monetary interest on public land? Why have we not been allowed to comment on the rerouting of the original alignment that was approved by all parties except one, again with financial interest, of the Upper Upper to Brush Creek trail. I would hope that one day the public would also be involved in the decisions regarding Eccher Gulch, Dr. Park reroute and Upper Cement Creek Extension. I am in full support of the CBMBA trail plan including the Lake Irwin Parallel trail, Lower Cement Creek to Caves, Reno Divide Parallel Trail, Upper Upper to Brush Creek (with the correct upper alignment), Deer Creek to Tent City, Budd Extension to Tent City, Teo Extension and Strand Bonus to 409.
