Comments: I would like to see some cabins on the Mitkof Island road system. A good place for a cabin on the main highway would be at the pull out two pull outs past the Blind river rapids board walk. It is about 100 yards to the grass flats along the river bank. This would be a year round used cabin site. Another possible locations could be the short stub road off Three Lakes road in the flat that ends at the creek. Don't know the mile marker but it is an old road that no longer has a bridge to cross the creek. Presently backed up with beaver dams.

Another location to consider would be past ten mile on Woodpecker cove road where the road comes back down near the water. Someplace near the creek mouth would be ideal.

The end of Ideal Cove road near the garnet mine area. Great view from there looking out over the flats or the big open muskeg back a short distance from the end of the road.

Toward the end of the Twin Creek road overlooking the large muskeg there.

Areas of interest off the island would be someplace in Dry Bay. Close to the mouth as the bay is dry most of the time. It also has a great sandy beach just outside of the bay.

Indian Point in Duncan Canal is a great location. Easy to get to and a boat can be anchored close by.

There is a cove located in the Castle Islands that has a great anchorage and a sand spit where there was an old cabin site in the past that would make a good cabin location too.
