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Comments: Thank you for soliciting input on cabin sites we feel would be valuable to SE communities. While we love getting on a boat and exploring cabins around SE Alaska this isn't always feasible for everyone. Petersburg currently has NO cabins you can drive to and camp at and I believe this should be a top priority for cabin sites. Wood Pecker has an already maintained road system and would be an ideal location anywhere along the water to put a cabin.

I also believe that up Frenchie Creek in the clearing where the current lean-to cabin is would be an ideal area to put a large full cabin. Keeping the small lean-to for day trips but adding an additional full cabin where people can access it year round by hiking, snowmobiling, snow shoeing or cross country skiing. (Think Dan Moeller Cabin in Juneau).

Additionally Cabin Creek Road system has beautiful views of the water and a cabin along that stretch of road would be easily accessible and very pretty views.

Three lakes would be another ideal location for a cabin. People could drive to the trail head and walk to the cabin site.

I hope Petersburg can see more cabins that will be able to be utilized by all demographics.
