Comments: The plans proposed by TSV are consistent with its Master Plan and will enable the resort to modernize critical infrastructure necessary to maintain a competitive appeal to guests and continue to be a crucial benefactor to the local (and needy) economy. The plans are consistent with the resort's goal of using energy and water resources more efficiently and reducing the load on the environment. Specifically, modernizing the lift infrastructure, installing a Base to Phoenix gondola, and upgrading the snowmaking water supply system will improve the efficiency and utilization of the mountain operations, and consume fewer resources.
