Comments: Hi, I wonder if such a large and seemingly indiscriminate culling of trees is really necessary.

For one, even partially burned trees can still be home to many bird species. It may be better to limit ourselves to trees close to major highways. Secondly, why do we need to clear 600 feet wide spaces, can't this be made reduce to say 50 feet? Lastly, my concern is that cutting these trees will eventually increase soil erosion on these mountain slopes. Instead of disposing of this dead wood for commercial purposes, it would make sense to leave the wood in the forest where it can decompose back into soil.

In any case, it would have made more sense to have such an action be reviewed by multiple environmental agencies, both private and public, prior to initiating this cut. I understand you have not done that.

My concern is specifically for the North zone of California.
