I am adamantly opposed to motorized boats on the lake and a second visitor center. This is not an amusement park. It is a natural, lightly developed lake and should be traversed only by human powered boats that do not pollute with noise or fossil fuels.

Bus parking should be at a distance from the existing visitor center, with all electric buses and an electric shuttle for those who cannot walk to the center. Preferably there would be buses circulating regularly for pickup and drop off, allowing a more flexible visit for individuals, rather than traveling in a herd, and negating the need for more paved parking.
