Comments: The Bitterroot Forest front project gives opportunity for many recreational opportunities. As part of the recreation component of the project, many trailheads could be expanded and new campsites created to spread out participants. Since many old roads are imbedded in the area from past fire fighting and logging, these would provide a base for loops up and down the Bitterroot front.
