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Comments: Cube Cove is healing from the damage caused by past logging, roads, and associated impacts, and the Forest Service's massive "restoration" program using heavy equipment is inappropriate for the Kootznoowoo Wilderness. Natural processes of restoration may be slow but will be best suited to the ecosystem in the long term. The Forest Service needs to step back and learn from those natural processes and to develop a better sense of what "wilderness" really means and its value for our country. There may be times for aggressive intervention and control in order to fix what we have damaged, but it is more often important to allow the remaining health of the system to express itself.
