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Comments: The Cube Cove project, violates the letter and spirit of the Wilderness Act, through its extensive use of chainsaws, helicopters, and other motorized equipment, on top of tree cutting. This area should be allowed to recover on its own, at its own pace and through natural processes, again, as the Wilderness Act stipulates.

We all understand how vital trees are for carbon storage, micro climates, soil stabilization, as well as, wildlife habitat. All of these are vital, especially at this time, with an ecological crisis and climate change pressure.

This project seems to be yet another excuse the forest service uses to remove trees for the benefit of special interests, rather than concern for the health of this wilderness ecosystem, which in my estimation, is why it is being proposed.

As a federal agency you really should obey the laws and leave this wilderness area to heal naturally.
