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Comments: I would like to pass along my concern for the proposal to put in "Alpine" ski huts out of the North Fork Teanaway. The proposal puts cabins and the main path of travel on existing groomed snowmobile trails and the areas for the cabins in areas that see common use. This is poorly planned and will be an obvious source of user conflict.

I am also confused why the USFS is pushing so hard to put in these huts in this region. The elevation of the proposed site is at 3,600' and would only share skiable areas that are used by snowmobiles. I don't think these projects should be the priority of the USFS but if they are then they should focus on finding a proper spot that wont promote user conflict.

Please keep in mind that user conflict between skiers and snowmobilers is heavily influenced by skiers "Claiming" areas as their own and not for others to use. Bringing that attitude into this area is not welcome.
