You know that many best practices are simply not held in favor by government agencies.

This your ability to engage in discussions with an open mindset is flawed.

Managing Land is different from managing a Forest.

There is a spiritual component that your science is not built to comprehend.

And this failing leaves the realm of mental health completely unaddressed.

You know this. And yet you push on.

As you have always done.

Time for others to get involved, and time for the government agencies to evolve.

There is no time any more for flawed, broken processes.
