Comments: I am concerned that an environmental impact assessment may be waived for this construction that is occurring in grizzly habitat, and in such close proximity to a lake. With guaranteed increased use of the trailhead by lodge guests the lodge should contribute to trailhead clean up and services such as bear proof trash and toilets. I would encourage the FS to ensure that local, affordable, access to the NF is not impeded by the presence of this lodge. The lodge should have plenty of bear proof trash storage if they could host events for over 150 people all year round. The lodge restaurant should be open to the public, not just lodge guests. The nearby campground should have their experience preserved (perhaps a noise curfew for events at the lodge). What are the annual public benefits received from this increase in use and revenue provided to a private entity on public land.
