- 1. I have been coming to Holland Lake with my family every summer since I was a kid. Turning it into a resort would make such experiences, along with the lessons I learned there, connections built with my family, immersion in nature, and appreciation of place impossible for all future generations.
- 2. It will actually ruin the current lodge, which is a rare and outstanding experience.

There are ever fewer places to experience the majestic natural beauty around Holland Lake. Money can build those resort experiences anywhere. But no amount of money could recreate Holland Lake.
