People on standup paddle boards, kayaks, and fishing boats have increased. I have no doubt that the increase and updating of the existing lodge will bring the same kind of activity and interfere with nesting loons in the future.

Lets protect our small lakes and discourage the larger crowds that will undoubtedly descend upon the lake once the property is enlarged. Keep the place intimate. Our population in Montana is increasing at such a rapid rate that the animal population is in danger of being driven out.
