Comments: Upon review of the numerous newly uploaded environmental documents on the Forest Service's Holland Lake project website, I would like to submit a comment.

The Forest Service has failed to give sufficient notice to the public which is in violation of NEPA requirements. We need more time to review the detailed documents and plans that were just uploaded to the website. NEPA requires that the public has a minimum of a month for public comments before such a controversial agency decision is made. We were not given that time in this case.

The Forest Service has also failed to consider the significant environmental impacts to endangered species and designated critical habitats that will result from the huge construction project planned. The Holland Lake area is home to endangered species and borders the Bob Marshall Wilderness Area. Very little discussion of the effect of the project on endangered animals and the Wilderness Area has been provided so I am unable to determine whether or not sufficient analysis of individual and cumulative effects of this project have been considered. Have the impacts of increased traffic to the Lake or the increases in sewage been fully evaluated?

I oppose this project and I believe that the The Forest Service needs to follow the requirements of NEPA before approving this project.
