Comments: I strongly object to the Forest Service Holland Lake Project. Not only has there been a significant failure on the part of the Forest Service to notify the public and provide sufficient time to review all that this project entails, there has been no consideration for impact studies of any kind.

This project was first introduced as a public meeting on September 8th. This was not a meeting but a presentation. When this event was overseen by three armed law enforcement officers, it was quite clear that it had nothing to do with gaining the support, consideration or cooperation of the community.
