This expansion will negatively affect the surrounding Bob Marshall Wilderness and will most certainly affect endangered and sensitive species including grizzly bears, Canada lynx, wolverine, and bull trout. Aside from the impact on pristine wilderness, permitting a large corporation to expand this resort will render the area inaccessible to the local population who don't make enough money to afford a high-end resort. A large development like what is being proposed is NOT appropriate for this area and requires, at a minimum, the thorough analysis of an Environmental Impact Study.
