Comments: I find the expansion of the Holland lake lodge to be very problematic. The rustic current Lodge fits with the primitive nature of Holland lake, a major entrance to the iconic Bob Marshall Wilderness. The planned restaurant, multiple lakeside cabins, massive parking lots, and other large buildings are simply not compatible with the site. I have had the privilege of spending the night at the primitive owl creek forest service rental cabin on two occasions in mid winter and taking the 10 minute walk over to Holland lake. Having a gigantic resort on the lake shore would have completely changed the character of that walk. Pollution from increased water usage by increasing guest numbers will be harmful to pristine Holland Lake as will increased car traffic and air pollution from the cars.
