Comments: I am opposed to the development proposed by Powdr on Holland Lake. The lake is too small for development of that size. The impact on wildlife such as loons, bears and Canada lynx to name a few would be adversely affected. Additionally water quality would suffer under the pressure of such an expanded facility.
