While it is indisputable that improvements are needed at the lodge, the proposal by POWDR exceeds what the property and by extension, Holland Lake, can withstand. My concerns are many. Sure, improve facilities, but don't erect 26 cabins, a lodge, more sewage pools, and increase by 3 fold the number of "beds"...ie profit.
