President Roosevelt established the Forest Service in 1905 to provide quality water and timber for the Nation's benefit. Over the past century, the public has expanded the list of what they want from national forests and grasslands. Congress responded by directing the Forest Service to equally manage national forests for multiple uses of renewable resources such as water, forage, wildlife, wood, and recreation. Multiple use means managing resources for the best combination of uses to benefit the American people while ensuring the productivity of the land and protecting the quality of the environment.

National forests are America's Great Outdoors. They encompass 193 million acres (78 million hectares) of landan area larger than Texas.
