Fully support ADA enhancements to the trail system, parking and bathrooms between the lower and upper trailhead parking areas. This would include paving, if necessary, the existing main trail and auxiliary trails to give access to Junction Creek. Not really in favor of extending the road paving past the upper parking lot to the trailhead. The portion between the two lots does get beat up and wash boarded by the amount of traffic between the lots during the summer. Paving beyond to camping area would add a lot of cost to the project if the grounds are include. If the campground is still only open part year, this seems not cost effective for the utilization compared to all year access to the lots. Paving beyond the campground is just asking for trouble. Folks that shouldn't be driving the roads, not used to the conditions are bad enough during the summer. Having people up on icy roads in the winter is looking for trouble with the inclanation around many curves.
