Comments: Custer Gallatin needs to think beyond immediate profit. There will be significant harm to wildlife if it's carried out. How can you, with good conscience, go into Yellowstone and cause harm?

As required by law: The Custer Gallatin needs to conduct an Environmental Impact Statement of all logging and road building underway and planned in Hebgen Basin, including in the South Plateau and North Hebgen.

Cumulatively logging over 20,000 acres of habitat and building 71 miles of roads - the equivalent of building a road from West Yellowstone to Ennis, Montana - is a major action and significant long-term harm to wildlife, soils, and water quality.

World class scenic views and visitors hiking the trails along the Continental Divide will also be harmed.
