Comments: Hello Timothy I am unable to find the comment area for the Junction Creek proposals of which we spoke, so I shall briefly write to you a few of my concerns. I understand the Forest Service is currently accepting public comment in regards to the Junction Creek/Falls Creek areas, and, that there will be future meetings and opportunity for public input, as this project is, at present, in its earliest stages. Briefly, I am concerned that there is consideration of chip coating or asphaltting the road from the lower parking lot up to the Animas Overlook, that there is consideration of expanding the upper and lower JC parking areas to accommodate 35 vehicles each, that there is consideration of an extensive mountain bike 'track' in the Log Chutes area, and, that the Forest Service would consider the idea of maintaining and grooming the road to the overlook during the winter, when the deer and elk herds are in need of respite from human encroachment. I want to speak for the preservation, of what still remains to us, of natural environments [hellip] a resource in itself. Are we to continue to reduce the quality of our 'outdoor experience', by over use; do we no longer examine our considerable impact on the natural world and other species? I will look forward to further discussions on these thoughts/proposals in the coming months, and appreciate very much your sending to me the Forest Service information.
