Comments: The proposed South Plateau Project on the western border of Yellowstone National Park should not go forward for a number of reasons. My primary concern is the disruption of endangered species habitat affecting grizzlies, wolverines, lynx and more critters who will be harmed by road building, extensive human activity and radical long term changes to their environment. There are very few areas left to serve as connecting corridors for increasingly isolated populations of some of our most threatened and prized wildlife to mingle with broad genetic pools and strengthen their chances of healthy species survival. The "South Plateau" area is critical for connecting Yellowstone wildlife populations with areas in the Gallatin and Madison ranges and further north. Please do not allow this project to go forward.
