- 1. Apply voluntary deed restrictions, or conservation easements, that prohibit industrial, commercial and residential development must be negotiated and analyzed as part of the EA and a condition of the exchange. If voluntary measures are not agreed to, the Forest Service should place land use restrictions on any wetlands, sensitive habitat and cultural sites prior to exchanging the land.
- 2. The Forest Service should reserve public and administrative access on sections 7, 8 and 10 in Sweetgrass drainage to maintain the status quo.
- 3. The Forest service should continue consultation and co-management with all regional Indigenous nations that identify as being connected to the Crazy Mountains.
- 4. Once the environmental analysis is complete, the public needs another opportunity to provide public comment.
- 5. The impacts of the land exchange and a new trail through previously unfragmented land should be thoroughly analyzed with a full Environmental Impact Statement
