Comments: The language now being used by profit oriented agendas to enable their logging of old growth forests (the most important existing natural resources for sequestering carbon, maintaining and honoring prime species diversity and prime ecosystem complexity, functionality, and sustenance) is now that certain forests are getting 'too old'.
