After reading the Lemon Gulch trail system environmental assessment, I am in full support of the Alternative 2 build plan. I am an avid mountain biker and excited to see more trails in central Oregon. I also recognize the economic and quality-of-life benefits the trail system would bring. I appreciate that the US Forest Service is interested in improving recreational opportunities for the land they manage.

However, I wary of growth at any cost, so I read the environmental assessment in detail before voicing my submitting my support. I support the full build detailed in Alternative 2 for the following reasons:

- *Potential ecological impacts appear limited to non-existent.
